County Transportation Committee Road Project List for Summer 2015

The following projects are presented for information and consideration by the County Transportation Committee.

ROAD PACKAGE # 1 - ALREADY APPROVED BY CTC

Under Contract - completion date approximately one month away:

SC secondary Aviation Boulevard- \$415,000

SC secondary Stacie Howie Road (resurface only / DOT crews have reclaimed and chip sealed) - \$82,000

Under contract- ongoing through 6/30/16

2015/2016 Calcium Chloride contract (dust control on county dirt roads) - \$106,000

Payment for completion of CDBG grant in Heath Springs (repairs on US 521 Main Street) - \$57,000

Commitment to Old Bailes Road widening for KEER- \$150,000. *(This was formerly a state secondary road which needed to be widened for an economic development project. It did not qualify under SCDOT guidelines and Lancaster County accepted the road into the county system to make the widening possible.)*

Total of committed funds for the above listed projects - \$810,000. This will take up the majority of the funding, and it looks like all will be completed this FY, with the exception of the KEER project, so they need to carry over at least \$150,000. Public Works Director Jeff Catoe will ask that the CTC consider under a discussion item at the next meeting to keep around \$300,000 on hand in reserve, mostly for emergency situations.

Jeff and Chief Financial Officer Veronica Thompson will segregate funds to avoid intermingling. Funds will be divided into Regular C Fund; One Time C Fund from Legislature; and Capital Project Sales Tax.

ROAD PACKAGE #3 – READY TO ADVERTISE AND LET – REGULAR C FUNDS

Henry Harris Road (*this is the county section – SCDOT is resurfacing the state secondary portion using Sales Tax funds*)

Deerwood Road - to be reclaimed by SCDOT in house crews and resurfaced by CTC, an agreement they've used well so far (Stacie Howie, Little Dude)

Total estimate: \$1,243,164.30

ROAD PACKAGE #4 – READY FOR CONSIDERATION BY CTC – ONE TIME C FUNDS

*Need to rework estimates and have CTC vote on at next meeting

DOT roads in Arrowood - \$400,000 - Sharon Lane/ Rosewood Lane/ Woodleaf Lane/ Dogwood Lane/ Blackstone Drive/ Maple Lane/ Terra Lane/ Holly Lane/ Hilltop Lane/ Freemont Drive/ Hickory Drive

Clinton Avenue- \$500,000

Hough Road- \$340,000, includes spurs

Neal Street- \$175,000

N Ashe Street- \$165,000

Valley Road- \$180,000

Sunnybrook Road - \$278,000

Sunshine Road- \$275,000

Cambridge/Ross Cauthen- \$265,000

Total estimate: \$2,578,000

*All roads are non-federal aid state secondary roads

***Collins Road

**These are federal aid roads, each over 2 miles. All except Cedar Pines are designed for 45 mph, so DOT will make them 24' wide. This should be pretty expensive.

***While Collins Road gets a lot of news, a new development has just started on it, and it will need bridge work.

All estimates are based on SCDOT figure of \$250,000 per mile. There are some contingencies added, but keep in mind, these numbers could go up or down by the time all factors are in and bids awarded.
