2020 Summer Day Camp Guidelines

In an effort to ensure camper and employee safety, the Summer Day Camp Program (SDC) will be structured differently this summer due to the safety protocols and measures required.

These guidelines are subject to change, based on guidance from the Governor, CDC, or our County Government.

- **Days/Hours of Operation:**

- Monday thru Friday from 6:30AM until 6:00PM
- Closed July 3rd in observance of Independence Day on July 4th
- Open June 8th thru August 21st

- **Fees/Payments:**

- Registration is required for each camper and the cost is \$25 per camper, which is non-refundable. This cost goes toward a camp t-shirt and supplies.
- Cost is \$90/week for one (1) camper & \$50/week for each additional camper who is a sibling that lives at the same household address, regardless of how many days you attend camp.
- Campers will be allowed to miss one week only for vacation without being charged for the week. (Please communicate with your Site Director regarding dates.)
- Payment is due on Fridays for the upcoming week. You will be required to pay ahead. No exceptions. Late fees will be applied if payment is not received by end of the day on Fridays. Those that have not paid will not be allowed to drop their child off on Monday of the next week.
- Cash/check payments will be accepted via drop box. If a parent needs a receipt at the time of payment, they will have to pull aside and we will get them one.
- Card Payments will be accepted through the online portal or LCPR can store the card on file and run it each Friday.
- All receipts will be emailed immediately following the process of payment/transaction. If you do not have an email address on file, we can add it for you.

- **Program Updates/Changes:**

- LCPR will limit the number of campers at sites based on current social distancing guidelines (5 campers per 1000 sq ft') at each site:
 - Indian Land Recreation Center-50 campers (chosen from lottery based on who has registered)
 - Andrew Jackson Recreation Center (Kershaw)- 50 campers
 - Springdale Recreation Center-70 campers
 - Buford Recreation Center-70 campers
- All County Recreation Centers will be closed to the public for other programming, such as open gym basketball or citizens walking during the SDC hours until further notice.
- All SDC campers and employees will be screened before entering the facility each day. Screenings include answering a series of health questions and a temperature check. Temperatures must be lower than 100 degrees.
- If a camper/employee has a fever, the camper/employee will not be allowed to return back to SDC until they are fever free, and have a physician's note saying that they are good to attend our SDC.
- Staff will monitor and discourage congregation throughout the day at camp.
- Parents will need to make an appointment with the Site Supervisor in advance if discussion is needed concerning your child.
- Campers need to bring lunch in a disposable bag. Please encourage your child not to share food items. Do not send items to be microwaved.
- No personal (blankets, pillows, backpacks, bags, cell phones, hair products, etc.) will be allowed, other than lunch, water bottle or medication.

- **Drop off procedures:**

- Staff will be stationed outside during drop off hours (6:30am-8:30am). If you drop off after 8:30am, you will need to call the Recreation Center for someone to assist you.
- Parents will drop off outside and must wait for temperature check before leaving. Parents will be asked a series of questions regarding their child's health.
- Each camper's temperature will be taken upon arrival.
- If a camper has a temperature, the person dropping the camper off will need to take the camper back home or make other arrangements.
- After the camper's temperature has been taken and they are cleared to attend that day, hand sanitizer will be given to that camper for them to use before proceeding to their designated area.

- **Pick-up Procedures:**

- Staff will be stationed outside during camper pick up hours (4:00pm-6:00pm). If you need to pick up prior to 4:00pm, then you will need to call the Recreation Center for someone to assist you.
- Staff will radio child to get his/her belongings to go home.

- **SDC format**
 - At this time, there will be no field trips this summer. If SDC field trips are reinstated, you will be notified in advance concerning the changes.
 - Campers will be assigned a station for them to go to each day and will adhere to social distancing guidelines.
 - Campers will be assigned their own personal plastic zip lock bag (their name on the bag for identification) with their personal designated camp supplies in the bag. Upon completion of the craft or activity, the camper will place their supplies back into the bag so they can use the next day.
 - The camper's bags will be passed out by staff at the beginning of the day/week, and picked up and stored at the end of the day/week.
 - As much as possible, campers will stay 6 feet apart.

- **Safety/Sanitation Guidelines:**
 - Hand washing w/soap and water before breakfast, lunch, and snack.
 - Hand washing w/soap and water after each trip to the restroom.
 - Hand Sanitizer before every activity.
 - Campers are welcomed and encouraged to wear an appropriate facemask that they bring from home. (masks are not required or provided)
 - Staff members not in designated PPE places will be encouraged to wear an appropriate facemask.
 - Besides the normal employee training that takes place, additional staff training concerning safety and sanitation guidelines will be provided.
 - Sanitation standards for each facility will be followed in accordance with the CDC.
